





I write to inform you that the City of Murfreesboro will shortly cease providing municipal services to your home and area. I am advised by the City's legal counsel that this action is advisable because of the lawsuit filed to challenge the annexation and the repeated demands of the plaintiffs in the lawsuit that the City cease its service activities.

The City regrets any disruption this may cause you. The City is today notifying all government agencies, utilities and other service providers who were informed that your status would change on August 12, 2006 to that of City residents of this legal development. This will make it unnecessary for you to notify them but of course you may do so as well if you wish. Those notified will include Rutherford County Government offices, including the Sheriff's office, 911, the Volunteer Fire Chiefs, Atmos, Comcast, MTEMC, CUD and all city offices. All offices who were notified of the annexation will receive such notification. For every service, this change will take effect at 11:59 p.m., Friday, September 15, 2006.
